Categories of Cloud Services



Infrastructure as a Service (laaS)

Rent virtual infrastructure such as computers, storage and networks to build a service

Common entry point for learning Billed base and moving to the cloud

Billed based on consumption



Platform as a Service (PaaS)

On-demand environments for developing, testing, and delivering applications

Quickly create apps and services without managing underlying infrastructure

Billed based on consumption



Software as a Service (SaaS)

Applications or services delivered over the internet

Ready-to-use applications available Billed by per-user subscription over the internet

Serverless Computing



Enables developers to create applications faster without the need to deploy infrastructure

- No infrastructure to manage
- Scalability
- Faster time to market
- Efficient use of resources

Shared Responsibility Model



The shared responsibility model defines the division of responsibility between the cloud provider and the customer for a given type of cloud service
